Target group	For refugees and migrants from any country. Foreigners with right of residence can also take part if they do not have access to other language courses.		
Other	Register at the Landratsamt Konstanz (AMI). Participation is free of charge. Travel expenses are reimbursed if there is proof of participation. Courses with a final examination (apart from the literacy course).		

Special rules:

Literacy course	Participants must not be attending school or subject to compulsory schooling.
Foundation course	Participants must not be attending school or subject to compulsory schooling.
Intermediate courses	Participants must not be attending school or subject to compulsory schooling. Minimum requirement for participation: Certificate A1.
Part-time course for parents or women	There should be a minimum of ten and maximum of 15 participants on the course. The course organiser will organise free-of-charge childcare during the course for children of the participants who are under school age. The reduced minimum number of participants should enable courses to take place in different district municipalities and make it easier for participants to have access to language courses near their place of residence.
Intensive language course	Young people and adults who are beginning training or an occupational training course at college full-time (particularly VABO/A/E, training preparation dual, BEJ and BF). Minimum requirement for participation: A2 and a continuing training.
Extra-occupational part-time language course for employed persons	Young people and adults who are in training or an occupational activity. The course aims to achieve language level B1 GER, B2 GER or C1 GER in 300 lesson units, if the participants can prove to have German knowledge at a language level directly below.
